Data Footnotes:

- (1) The 'Mean Relative Standard Error' is a measure of the relative precision of the wage estimate. A low number denotes relatively high validity.
- (2) For some occupations, workers may not work full-time all year-round. For these occupations it is not feasible to calculate an hourly wage.
- (3) An estimate of employment could not be provided.
- (4) An estimate of wage could not be provided.
- (5) There is wide variation in the number of hours worked by those employed as actors, dancers, musicians, and singers. Many jobs are for a duration of 1 day or 1 week and it is extremely rare for a performer to have guaranteed employment for a period that exceeds 3 to 6 months.
